In the figure ground studies the cap was used in multiple cases because of its unique curvature design to study both plan and section form ideas which in the end informed the design. 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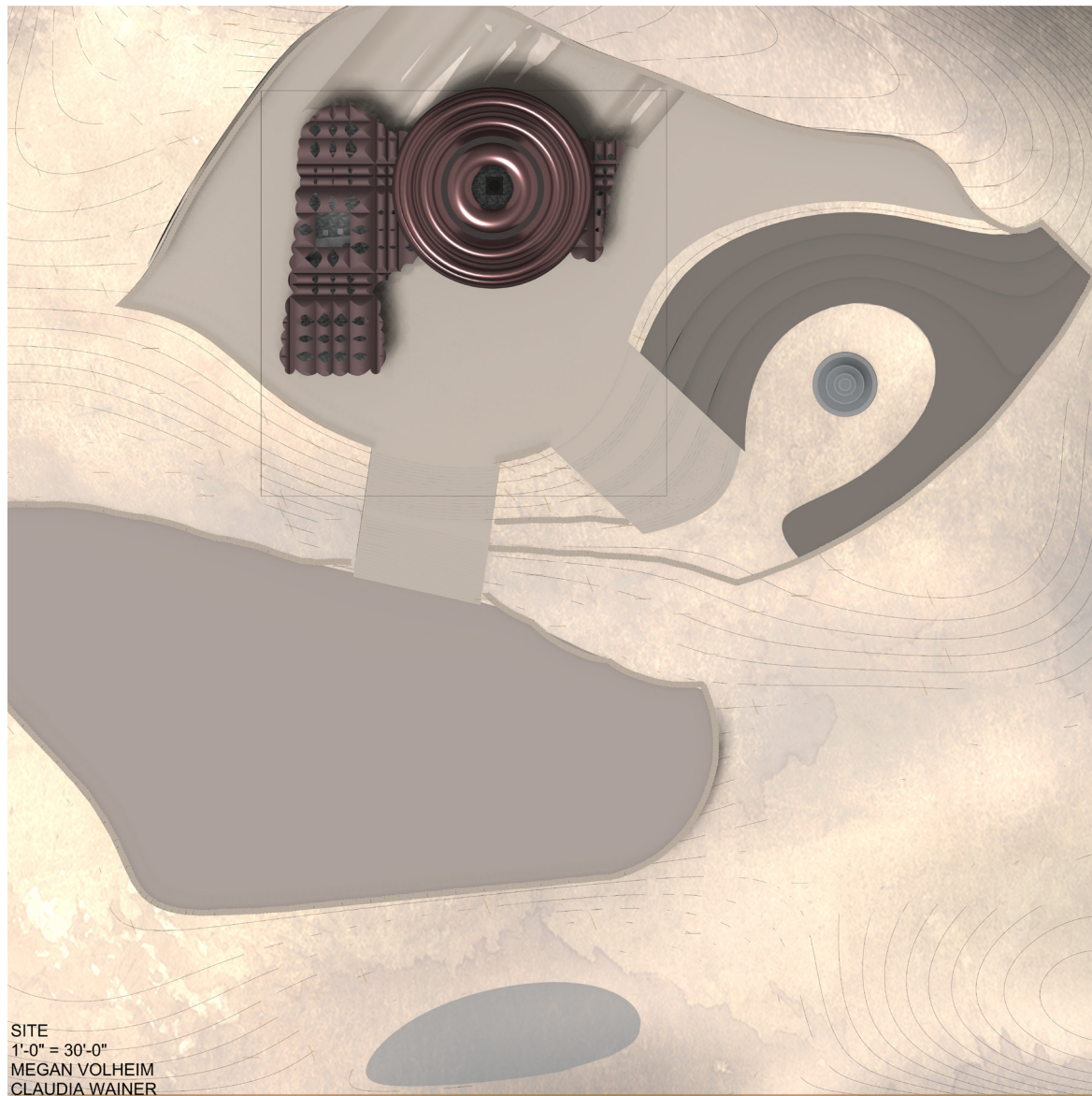


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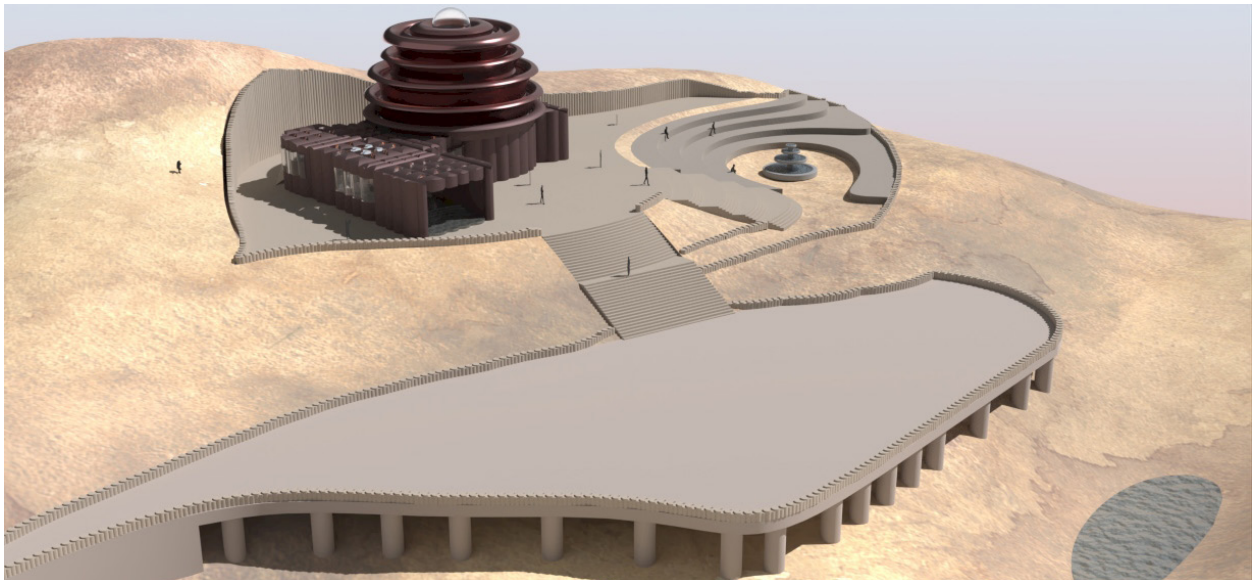
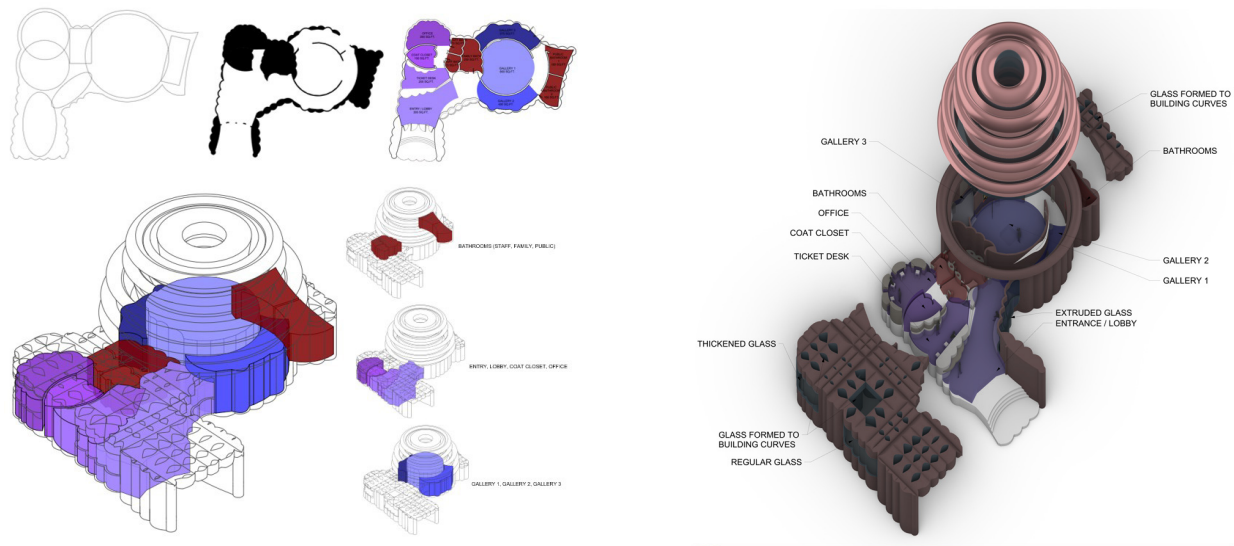
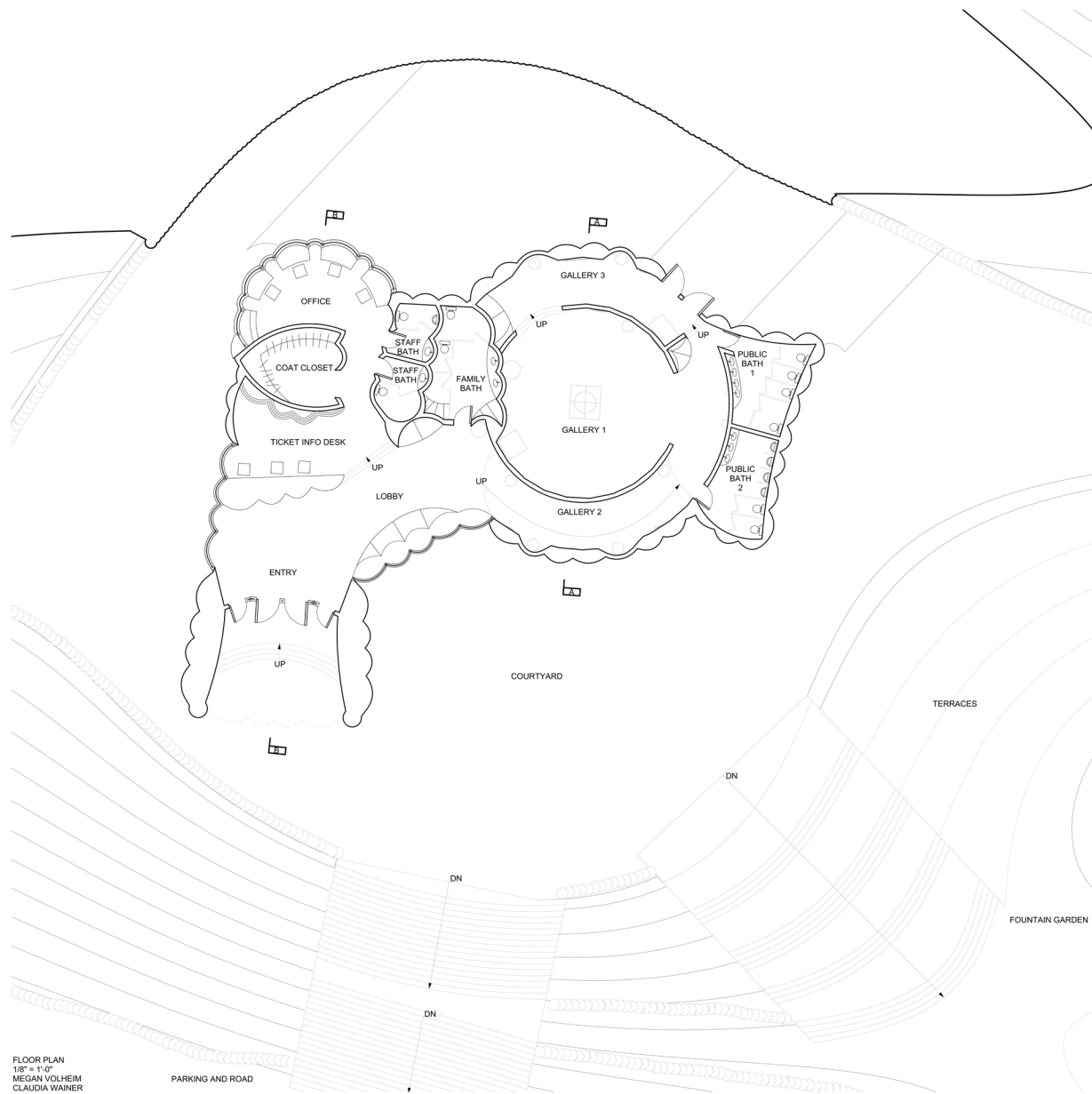
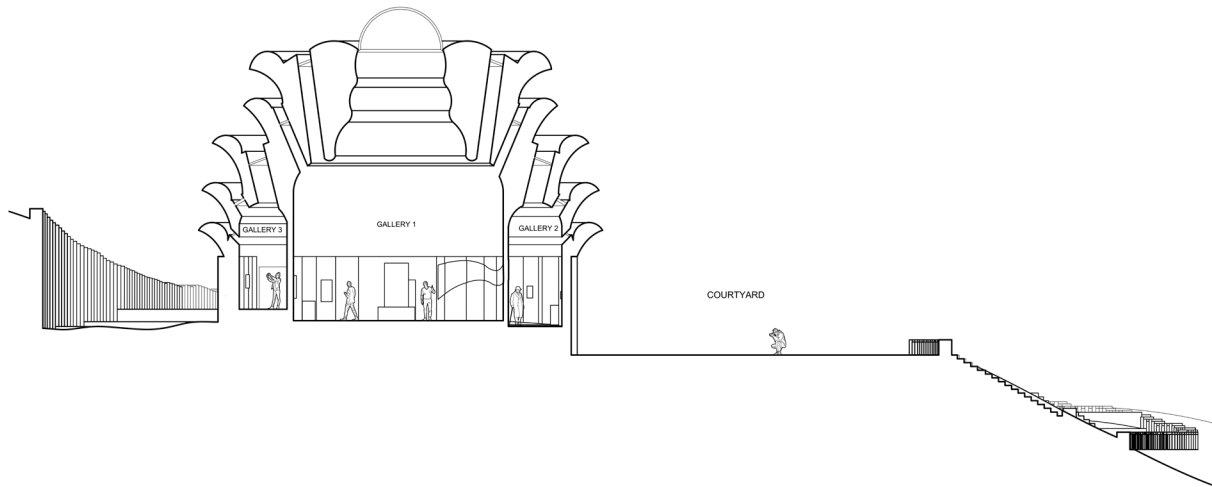


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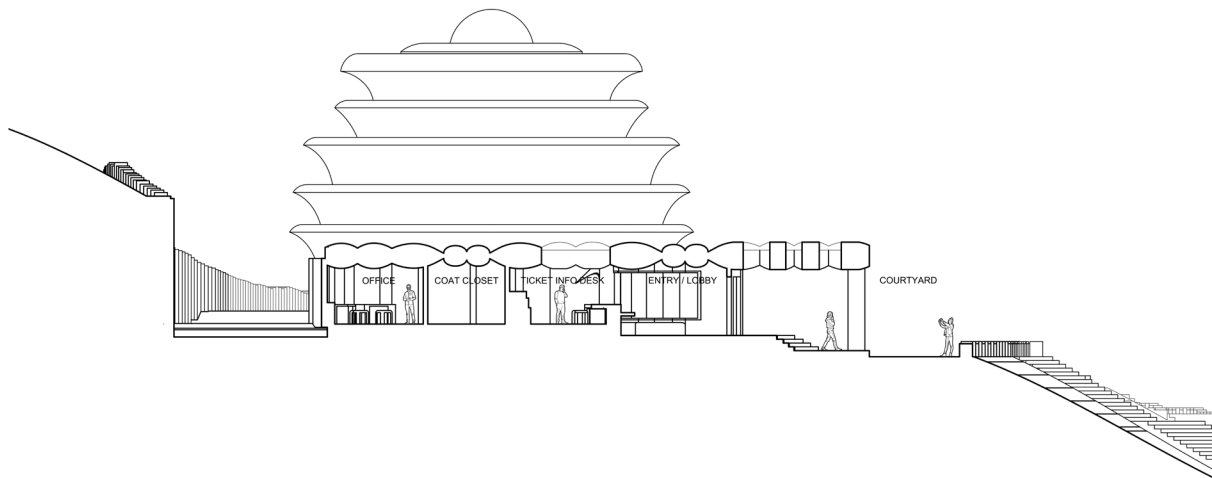


FLOOR PLAN
